

ENG Instructions for using an artificial Christmas tree

Dear customer, thank you for purchasing our product. Read and follow the following instructions carefully to prevent misuse or damage to the product. Keep the operating instructions in a safe place.

Description

- the tree is made of steel annealed wire and PVC or PE material
- consists of 1, 2 or 3 parts according to the total size
- plastic stand contains 3 or 4 legs, larger trees may have a metal stand

Mounting instructions

1. First, unpack the tree from the box and spread it on the ground.
2. Turn the largest part of the tree upside down, insert it into the round plastic center of the stand leg and put it into the predetermined holes as far as it will go. Then turn the tree over and place the stand on the ground.
3. Spread the twigs. Always start from the bottom. For the umbrella system, let it fall freely into place or gently pull it down. For the expansion system, the twigs must be manually extended to a 90° position.
4. If the tree consists of several parts, place the second part on the first part, spread the twigs again and, if necessary, continue with the third part of the tree in a similar way.
5. Spend the most time on arranging the twigs. Always model from the center to the end of the twig. For new and smaller trees, the twigs can be stiff, don't be afraid to push harder.
6. Always try to spread the twigs to the other side so that they are not all in one row. Always spread the last row of twigs on a branch into a star so that the tree has a full shape and a richer appearance.

Warning

1. The trees are only for indoor use.
2. Assembly and disassembly of the tree is not intended for children.
3. Take extra care when handling to avoid scratching/injuring the wire - we recommend using protective gloves (not included).
4. Do not expose the tree to open flames, such as candles or sparklers.
5. It is common for decorated trees that the package may contain excessive decoration from the production process - this is not a defect.
6. Do not let children or animals lick or taste trees with imitation snow.
7. In case of placing the tree on underfloor heating, we recommend purchasing metal stand.

Storage

1. Remove all decorations from the Christmas tree, including the hooks. This will prevent any unpleasant injuries during subsequent installation.
2. Clean only with a duster or carefully with a wet cloth.
3. Always disassemble the tree from the top. Carefully push the twigs back to the branch and then the branches to the trunk, pulling the whole part of the tree upwards. Continue in the same way for the other parts.
4. Carefully put the tree back in the box or in the prepared bag/plastic.
5. Store the tree in a dry place, out of direct sunlight. Do not expose to high temperatures, as the needles may be deformed.
6. We recommend storing white trees and those with imitation snow in a cardboard box - long-term exposure to UV radiation can change the shade of white.
